



Girls' Hostel No. 2

College of Veterinary Science (CVSc), Assam Veterinary and Fishery University, Khanapara.

Girls' Hostel No. 2 is one of the residential hostels for girl students at the College of Veterinary Science, Khanapara campus of Assam Veterinary and Fishery University. The hostel was established in the year 1992 to provide dedicated accommodation facilities for women students pursuing their academic programmes at the College.

The building was initially constructed and used as a Guest House. Subsequently, considering the increasing requirement for residential facilities for women students, it was converted into Girls' Hostel No. 2. Since then, it has been functioning as a full-fledged hostel under the supervision of the Directorate of Students' Welfare.

Dr. Chandana Chaudhuri Barua was the first Warden of the hostel and played a key role in its early administration and organization.

The hostel is a two-storied building with a total of 14 shared rooms and an approved intake capacity of 46 students. At present, the hostel is fully occupied with 46 boarders.

Room Details

Girls' Hostel No. 2 consists of **14 rooms** with different seating capacities designed to accommodate boarders comfortably while maintaining a conducive academic environment.

General Features of Rooms

- Well-ventilated and adequately lighted.
- Furnished with standard hostel furniture (study table, chair, and storage space) as per hostel provisions.
- Electricity facility with permissible light fittings (as per hostel rules).
- Clean and peaceful environment suitable for study and rest.

Category-wise Room Distribution

3-Seater Rooms

- Designed to accommodate three boarders.
- Suitable for group study while ensuring personal space.
- Ideal balance between companionship and privacy.

5-Seater Rooms

- Spacious rooms with accommodation for five boarders.
- Suitable for junior batches or larger group allocations.
- Promote cooperative living and bonding.

2-Seater Rooms

- Designed for two boarders.
- Provide comparatively quieter and more private living space.
- Suitable for senior boarders or as per allotment discretion.

Total Accommodation Capacity

- **Total Rooms:** 14
- **Total Capacity:** 46 Boarders

Drinking Water Facility

Safe drinking water facilities are available within the hostel premises. The hostel is equipped with both RO (Reverse Osmosis) and Aquaguard water purification systems to ensure access to clean and safe drinking water for all residents.

Girls' Hostel No. 2 continues to provide a secure, comfortable and supportive residential environment conducive to academic excellence and overall personal development.

Mess and Dining Facility

The hostel has a functional mess facility for the boarders. A regular hostel mess is available within the premises, where both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals are served. The mess is managed by a Student Committee, ensuring active participation of boarders in the planning and supervision of food services. The dining hall has a seating capacity of approximately 30 students at a time. At present, the approximate mess charge per month is ₹ 1,530.00 (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Only).

The hostel provides a range of facilities to ensure a safe, comfortable and academically supportive residential environment for its boarders. Wi-Fi connectivity is available to facilitate academic and personal communication needs. A reading room and a common room are provided for study and recreational purposes. Facilities for both indoor and outdoor games are available to promote physical fitness and recreational engagement. The hostel is equipped with a television facility as well as access to newspapers and magazines for general awareness and entertainment. To ensure safety and uninterrupted functioning, power backup facilities are available, and the premises are monitored through CCTV surveillance. A security guard is deployed for round-the-clock safety of the residents. Basic first aid facilities are also maintained within the hostel, and a designated visitor's room is available to facilitate meetings with guardians and visitors in a regulated manner.

Safety and Security

The hostel maintains strict safety and security measures to ensure the well-being of all residents. The prescribed entry time for boarders is 6:00 PM, and the main gate is closed at 6:00 PM to maintain discipline and security within the premises. Visitors are permitted between 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM, subject to adherence to hostel regulations.

A security guard is deployed on duty round the clock to ensure continuous monitoring and safety of the hostel premises. In addition, fire safety equipment is installed in the hostel, and necessary precautions are maintained to address any emergency situation effectively.

Academic Achievements of Boarders

The Girls' Hostel No. 2 has consistently maintained a strong academic culture, with its boarders achieving notable distinctions in university examinations. The academic accomplishments of its boarders reflect the disciplined and supportive environment maintained within the hostel.

Miss Kangkana Sharma secured the position of Topper in the Second Year B.V.Sc. & A.H. class during the academic session 2020–21. Continuing her outstanding academic performance, she again secured the position of Topper in the Third Year B.V.Sc. & A.H. class during the academic session 2021–22. Her consistent excellence serves as an inspiration to fellow boarders.

In the First Year B.V.Sc. & A.H. class of the academic session 2024–25, **Miss Neelakshi Dutta** achieved the distinction of securing the First Position (Topper), demonstrating commendable academic dedication at the beginning of her professional course.

During the same academic session 2024–25, **Miss Sarbana Yasmin Ahmed** secured the Second Position in the First Year B.V.Sc. & A.H. class, further highlighting the strong academic performance of the boarders of Girls' Hostel No. 2.

These achievements underscore the hostel's commitment to fostering an environment conducive to academic excellence, discipline and holistic development among its boarders.
