

1. Basic Information

KBR Hostel, a boys' hostel, was established in the year 1989 to cater to the increasing demand for student accommodation during the late 1980s. Originally conceptualized as a "200 bedded boys hostel," it became functional in 1989 and was inaugurated by Dr. P. C. Bora, the then Vice-Chancellor of Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat. The construction was undertaken by Late Mantu Bora. Subsequently, the residents proposed naming the hostel "Kalaguru Bishnu Rabha Hostel," which is popularly known as KBR Hostel. The hostel has a total intake capacity of 112 students, with a present occupancy of 86. It comprises a ground floor plus two additional floors (G+2) and accommodates students in 56 rooms. The first wardens of the hostel were Dr. K. K. Sarma (W/W) and Dr. P. Chakravarty (E/W).

2. Room Details

The hostel primarily consists of double occupancy rooms, ensuring a balanced living environment for students. Provision of safe drinking water is available through a reverse osmosis (RO) system equipped with a cooling facility, ensuring both quality and convenience for the residents.

3. Mess and Dining Facility

The hostel has an operational mess facility that provides both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals to the boarders. The mess is managed by a student committee, promoting participatory management and accountability among residents. The dining hall has a seating capacity of approximately 25–30 students at a time. The approximate monthly mess charge is ₹ 2,000.00 (Rupees Two Thousand Only), making it economical and student-friendly.

4. Facilities Available

KBR Hostel offers a range of facilities aimed at ensuring a comfortable and engaging residential experience. These include a common room for recreational activities, indoor and outdoor games facilities to promote physical well-being, and television for entertainment. Newspapers and magazines are made available for academic and general awareness. The hostel is equipped with power backup facilities to ensure uninterrupted essential services. Security is maintained with the presence of a security guard, and CCTV surveillance systems are installed. A first aid facility is also available to address immediate health concerns. Additionally, a designated visitor's room is provided for receiving guests.

5. Safety and Security

The hostel maintains structured timings to ensure discipline and safety among residents. The entry and exit timing for students is fixed at 7:30 PM, while the main gate is closed at 9:00 PM. Visitor hours are scheduled between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM. The hostel is equipped with fire safety equipment, ensuring preparedness in case of emergencies. Appropriate security arrangements are in place to maintain a safe and secure environment for all boarders.
