



# **NEW GIRLS HOSTEL**

## **1. Basic Information**

The New Girls Hostel, established on 14th July 2014, is a well-planned residential facility designed to provide a safe, comfortable, and academically conducive environment for girl students. Since its inception, the hostel has been functioning efficiently under dedicated administrative supervision, with Dr. Arpana Das, Professor (Department of Animal Genetics and Breeding) serving as the first Warden. The hostel has a total intake capacity of 90 students, with a present occupancy of 79, reflecting its optimal utilization. The building is structured over 2 floors and consists of 44 rooms, ensuring adequate space and accommodation for residents. The hostel environment emphasizes discipline, cleanliness, and a supportive atmosphere for both academic and personal development.

## **2. Room Details**

The hostel provides a variety of accommodation options to suit the needs of students, including 2 single rooms, 42 double rooms, and 1 dormitory. Each room is designed to ensure proper ventilation, natural lighting, and a comfortable living space for the occupants. The arrangement promotes both privacy and a sense of community among students. Continuous availability of safe and hygienic RO drinking water ensures the health and well-being of the residents. The hostel infrastructure is maintained regularly to ensure cleanliness, functionality, and a pleasant living environment.

## **3. Mess & Dining Facility**

The hostel is equipped with a well-organized mess facility that caters to both vegetarian and non-vegetarian dietary preferences of the students. The mess is managed by a student committee, which ensures transparency, accountability, and active participation of residents in decision-making. The dining hall, with a seating capacity of 64 students, provides a

comfortable and hygienic space for meals. Emphasis is placed on maintaining food quality, cleanliness, and timely service. The approximate monthly mess charge is ₹ 1,500/-, making it economical and accessible for students while ensuring nutritious meals.

#### **4. Facilities Available**

The hostel offers a range of essential facilities aimed at enhancing the overall living experience of the students. A dedicated reading room provides a quiet and focused environment for academic activities, while the common room serves as a space for relaxation and interaction among residents. The availability of a television facility adds to recreational options. The hostel is equipped with reliable power backup to ensure uninterrupted functioning during power outages. CCTV surveillance and security guard services contribute to maintaining a secure and monitored environment. Additionally, first aid facilities are readily available to address any immediate health needs of the residents.


#### **5. Safety & Security**

Safety and security are given utmost priority in the hostel. The entry and exit timing is regulated, with 7:00 PM designated as the standard time for return and gate closing, ensuring discipline and safety. Visitor access is permitted during daytime hours under regulated conditions. The hostel maintains a structured security arrangement with personnel assigned for both day and night duties, ensuring continuous monitoring of the premises. The presence of fire safety equipment further strengthens preparedness against emergencies. Overall, the hostel provides a secure, well-regulated, and supportive environment conducive to student welfare and academic focus.
