



YAMUNA GIRLS' HOSTEL

1. Basic Information

Yamuna Girls' Hostel, established in 2019, is a residential facility dedicated to accommodating female students of the University. The first warden of the hostel was Dr. Nazrin Sultana Ahmed.

The hostel has an approved intake capacity of 39 students and currently houses 32 boarders. The building consists of two floors (Ground Floor plus First Floor) and comprises a total of 19 rooms, providing a comfortable and secure living environment within the campus.

2. Room Details

The hostel offers both double and triple occupancy accommodation, comprising 18 double rooms and one triple room. Safe drinking water is provided through an RO purification system, ensuring a clean and reliable water supply for all residents.

3. Mess & Dining Facility

The hostel has a fully functional mess that provides both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals for residents. The dining hall has a seating capacity of 30 students at a time. The approximate mess charge is ₹2,000 per month. The mess is managed as per the hostel's administrative arrangement to ensure smooth functioning and quality meal services for the residents.

4. Facilities Available

The hostel provides Wi-Fi connectivity for students to support academic and online activities. Outdoor games facilities are available for physical recreation, and a television facility is provided for entertainment. Power backup ensures continuity of essential services during power interruptions. For safety and well-being, the hostel has a security guard on duty and


first aid facilities to address minor medical needs. A visitor's room is also available for residents to meet guests in a designated area.

5. Safety & Security

The hostel follows regulated entry and exit timings from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM to ensure the safety and discipline of residents. The main gate is closed at 10:00 PM. Visitors are permitted between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM only.

For additional supervision and security, a matron is present in the hostel during working hours to monitor activities and assist residents when required.
