WALK-IN-INTERVIEW

As per the approval of the Director of Research, A.V.F.U., 'Walk-in-interview' will be held on **10th August, 2026 at 11:00 A.M.** in the **Seminar Hall of the Department of Animal Biotechnology, Faculty of Veterinary Science, Assam Veterinary and Fishery University, Khanapara, Guwahati-22** to fill up one temporary post of Project Technical Support-II (PTS-II) under the ICMR-funded Project on '*Development of novel multiplex based point of care (M_POC) diagnostic for Brucellosis, Leptospirosis, Scrub typhus and Coxiellosis (Q fever) and to unravel zoonotic diseases dynamics at human and animal Interface in Assam, North East India*'. Terms and Conditions:

- At the time of interview, the candidates have to submit a copy of their BIODATA (format enclosed), one set of hard copies of all relevant documents (self-attested) and a Bank Draft of Rs. 50.00 (Rupees Fifty only) / Rs.25.00 (Rupees Twenty-five only) for ST/SC candidates (separately for each post applied for), drawn in favour of Director of Research (Veterinary) payable at SBI, Khanapara, Guwahati. They shall have to also produce the original documents for verification at the time of interview.
- This is a multicentric project and works will be conducted in collaboration with the other two centers at GMCH, Guwahati and NIVEDI, Bangalore, selected candidates will have to visit the collaborating centers and field for training/sample collection as and when required.
- The post is purely temporary and coterminous with the project. The recruitment will be initially for one year and will be extended further based on satisfactory performance of the incumbent.
- Candidates capable of undertaking extensive tour throughout North-East India for collecting animal disease related data and samples as well as to conduct training programmes only need to apply.
- No TA/DA is admissible to the candidates for attending the interview.
